

DRESS CODE

Shirts: solid collared polos *with* Crestwell logo (embroidered or patch) in gray, white, sky blue, navy blue, forest green, or kelly green

- » Oversized shirts must be tucked in; fitted neat shirts may be left untucked
- » Collared shirt required Monday-Thursday (see Friday special notes under Additional Notes section)

Shorts & Pants/Slacks

- » Shorts and pants/slacks must be solid color: black, khaki, or navy
- » Shorts must be mid-thigh or longer
- » No leggings or yoga pants/shorts, stretch pants/shorts, excessively tight pants/shorts, or spandex or knit pants/shorts (only acceptable under a skirt)
- » No large, bulging pockets
- » No stripes on pants, shorts, skirts, or dresses

Skirts

- » Solid color: black, khaki, or navy
- » Mid-thigh or longer
- » No stripes on pants, shorts, skirts, or dresses

Jumpers & Polo Dresses

- » Solid color with Crestwell logo in gray, white, sky blue, navy blue, forest green, or kelly green
- » Mid-thigh or longer
- » Leggings may be worn under dresses
- » No stripes on pants, shorts, skirts, or dresses

Shoes & Socks

- » Sneakers or shoes are acceptable
- » Sneakers must be worn in recess and PE
- » Shoes must have backs (no flip flops, slides, clogs, or Crocs)
- » Heels must be less than 1 inch

PE Grades 5-8 (*Grades IK-4 do not change for PE*)

- » Crestwell logo t-shirts and gym shorts or pants, socks, and sneakers are required. PE uniforms are ONLY available for purchase directly from the school.
- » All jewelry must be removed during PE

Accessories

- » Hats are permissible for all outdoor activities
- » Jewelry: 1 necklace, 1 bracelet, 1 ring permitted
- » Makeup: makeup, hairspray, hair gels, perfume, spray deodorant, etc. may not be brought to school

Additional Notes

- » Fridays are fun! This is the only day jeans are permitted (Jeans with distressing and small holes are permissible. Holes or rips should not be above mid-thigh) with any Crestwell logo shirt
- » School trips require a collared Crestwell logo shirt and uniform bottoms
- » Only students in dress code will be permitted in class. Students may call home for acceptable attire
- » All clothes should be in good repair, solid colors, and not offensive
- » No graffiti on clothing or shoes permitted
- » Other special dress days are indicated on the monthly calendar updates
- » Only natural hair colors are permitted (hair color may be changed, but only to another natural hair color)

How to Buy and Embroidery/Patch

- » Lands' Énd, The Children's Place, Target, and Old Navy all carry a year-round selection of polos and non-PE shorts/skirts that meet our criteria (they must then have embroidery or logo patch added). Please ensure you are following our school colors as described above
- » Bulk uniform orders are available through the office twice per year
- » All Uniform Wear on Cleveland Avenue embroiders the Crestwell logo on all dress-code-approved clothing
- » The front office of Crestwell School will also have patches available for purchase on a first-come first-serve basis
- » Patches can be sewn on by your local dry cleaner for a nominal fee
